



SIGNS IT'S TIME TO REPLACE YOUR DISHWASHER

1. Leaking

Spotting water on the floor could be a sign that you need a new dishwasher. You should never see water leaking from the machine, and this can cause water damage in your kitchen. A small amount of leaking can often be fixed by a service technician, but if it gets worse, it may be time to replace it.

2. Rust

Rust on the inside of your dishwasher can be a sign that there is a leak in your machine. Check to see if the rust is leftover from dishes touching the tub during the last load. If the machine itself is corroding, rust could be contaminating your clean dishes.

3. Dishes Don't Come Out Hot or Clean

If the dishwasher is not doing its job to clean the dishes, then you should look into replacing the machine. The dishes should come out hot to the touch, as the FDA states a temperature of at least 170°F is necessary to sanitize.

4. Unusual Noises

Unusual noises coming from the dishwasher is not only a distraction to your staff but could also be a sign there is a serious issue. You want to get your machine checked before any major damage occurs.

5. Age of Machine
