

**FLIGHT TYPE
OWNER PROACTIVE MAINTENANCE**



INTRODUCTION

This customer proactive maintenance (PM) form includes procedures to inspect for proper operation of the dishwasher on a regular basis. To maintain the safety and performance of FT dishwasher, a program of scheduled periodic maintenance must be implemented.

NOTE: This PM procedure does not discuss repair or replacement of components. Upon completion of the PM procedure you will need to contact a qualified servicer for any needed repairs.

NOTE: For procedures, refer to Operator Manual.



⚠ WARNING Disconnect the electrical power to the machine and follow lockout / tagout procedures.

	<p>Clean Dishwasher: Do not touch until dishwasher is cooled.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Open all front access doors (daily). ✓ Drain all dishwasher tanks (daily). ✓ Remove and clean all curtains, using a mild detergent and scrub brush (daily). ✓ Remove and clean strainer baskets and pans (daily). ✓ Remove and clean upper and lower wash and rinse arms (daily). ✓ Flush tanks with a water hose: (daily) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> drain wash tank <input type="checkbox"/> drain hub area <input type="checkbox"/> strainer pans <input type="checkbox"/> overflow covers <input type="checkbox"/> pump guard <input type="checkbox"/> standpipe strainers <input type="checkbox"/> heating elements <input type="checkbox"/> tank interior <input type="checkbox"/> tank bottom ✓ Clean machine exterior. Use damp cloth with mild soapy water (daily). ✓ Clean door seals and interior door release (weekly). ✓ Delime unit as required.
	<p>Switches: Verify switch operation.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Dish rack start. ✓ Play button on keypad. ✓ Door switches: dishwasher stops when door(s) open.
	<p>Water Leaks: Check for water leak(s).</p>
	<p>Display: Verify all numbers and letters light up.</p>
	<p>Drain Line: Inspect and ensure all tanks drain freely.</p>

After completion of the owner PM procedure, you will need to contact a qualified servicer for any needed repairs.
